Travel

You will be responsible for all your own travel arrangements. Please wait until you receive your registration from the National Office to book your travel.

Start Time/Place

Registration will be held from 12:30-1:00p.m. on Friday, January 27th in HP 124 at:

Park in the East parking structure on the back side of campus. Parking is \$5 per day and will be enforced by campus police.

From the 215 freeway:

Take 215 North and exit at University Parkway. Turn right off of the exit. University Parkway dead ends directly into campus.

The opening session will begin at 1:00pm. All candidates need to check-in and receive course materials.
